Must be able to lift and/or carry up to 50 pounds and able to withstand prolonged periods of standing, frequent bending, stooping, reaching, pulling and pushing.

Children Services Minimum Requirements – At least 18 years of age, have a high school diploma or GED and one year of relevant experience working with children. Must be able to read and write fluently in English and have working knowledge of computer skills (Microsoft Office programs). Must be able to lift and/or carry up to 25 pounds and able to withstand prolonged periods of standing, frequent bending, stooping, reaching, pulling and pushing.
