Community Award Category (*Presented only to people/businesses/organizations in the community*)

COMMUNITY INCLUSION AWARD

Presented to an individual or group in our community who has clearly demonstrated identifying, creating or sustaining an inclusive community that embraces and engages individuals and families affected by intellectual and developmental disabilities.

ADVOCATE OF THE YEAR

Presented to an individual, legislator, business or community group who has contributed to the inclusion, dignity and welfare of people with intellectual and developmental disabilities, and whose actions have resulted in conditions significantly improving the quality of life of an individual(s), systemic change in response to their special needs, or protection of their basic human, civil or legal rights.

SELF ADVOCATE OF THE YEAR

Presented to an individual with intellectual and developmental disabilities who resides in Montgomery County who has attained a personal achievement or demonstrated a contribution to his/her community.

EMPLOYER OF THE YEAR AWARD

Presented to an employer in either the public or private sector who has made a significant contribution in hiring and assisting the employment of citizens with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

COMMITMENT TO EDUCATION AWARD

Presented to an individual or organization who has clearly contributed to the education of children and youth with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

PUBLIC SERVICE AWARD

Presented to an individual, business, or organization in recognition of outstanding public service on behalf of people with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

Presented to an individual under the age of 18 who, over the past year, has exhibited exceptional commitment and volunteer efforts on behalf of people with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

VOLUNTEER OF THE YEAR

Presented to an individual age 18 or older who, over the past year, has exhibited exceptional commitment and volunteer efforts on behalf of people with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

BOARD MEMBER OF THE YEAR

Presented to a member of The Arc Montgomery County Board of Directors who, over the past year, has exhibited exceptional commitment and volunteer efforts on behalf of people with disabilities.

RISING STAR AWARD

Presented to an individual in his/her first year of employment (having successfully completed the introductory period), who has gone above and beyond the expectations of his/her job description and has demonstrated outstanding work on behalf of the agency, its staff and the individuals we support.

DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD

Presented to a staff member of The Arc who exemplifies professionalism at its highest level over an extended time period. This person may be any staff member who shows qualities of leadership which significantly contribute to the field of intellectual and developmental disabilities, demonstrate the agency's mission, and set a standard for others to follow.
