TIPS FOR MAINTAINING MEDICAID ENROLLMENT



Know Your Medicaid Redetermination Date



Be on the lookout for an application in the mail about 60 days before that date.

Register for myMDTHINK



- This gives you electronic access to your redetermination date and lets you upload your redetermination packet.
- You can also register for electronic notifications to avoid delays with the postal service.

Submit Your Redetermination Packet 30-45 Days Before the Due Date



- The earlier, the better! Waiting to submit until the due date delays the renewal process and can put your services at risk.
- It's best to submit your application electronically in the myMDTHINK system.
- If you submit electronically, you will receive an electronic confirmation that you should keep as proof of submission.
- If you complete a paper application, send it certified mail, return receipt requested, and keep the green card you get back from the post office.
- Remember to sign the paper application. If you cannot sign your name, you can make a mark on the signature line.

Make Sure All Financial Information is Submitted



- Bank statements
- Life insurance policies that have a cash value
- · Retirement accounts or annuities
- Trust accounts held in your name or for which you are the beneficiary
- The Eligibility Determination Division (EDD) is looking at the value of assets on the first day of the month **that the redetermination application is submitted** (not the first day of the month it is due).
