Program Divisions

Children & Youth Services

Inclusive preschool care, before/after school care, and summer care for children ages 6 weeks-10 years with and without disabilities, plus after-school/summer care for youth ages 11-21 years.



Family & Community Services

Customized, person-centered support services for adults with disabilities provided on an hourly basis, to assist with tasks of daily living, social and recreational activities, and transportation.



Community Living Services

Support services for adults with disabilities at one of 38 homes located throughout Montgomery County, to assist with tasks of daily living, social/recreational activities, and routine house maintenance.



Vocational & Day Services

Support services for adults with disabilities related to job placement, on-site training, support and supervision, community volunteer opportunities and active retirement options.
